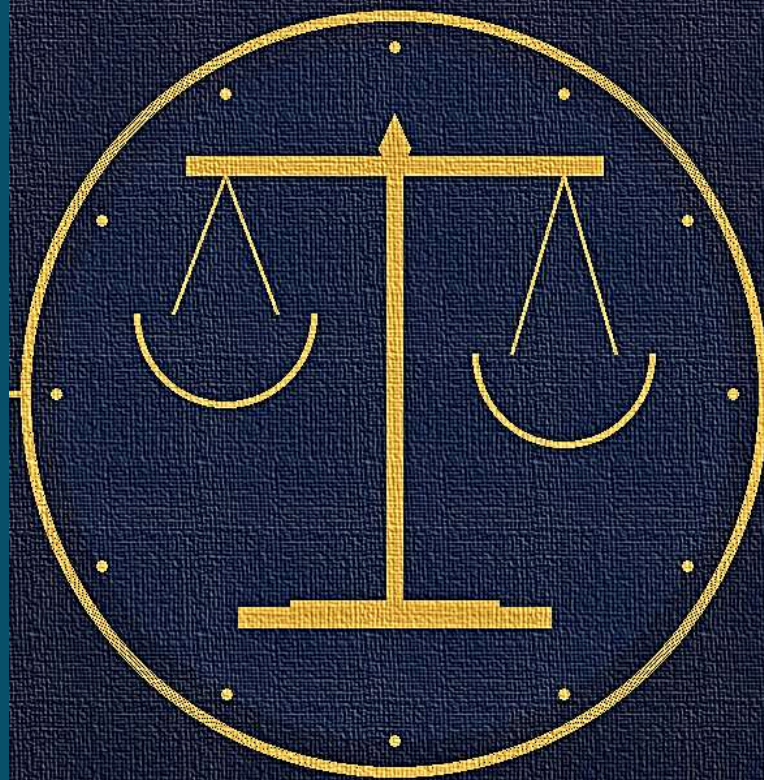

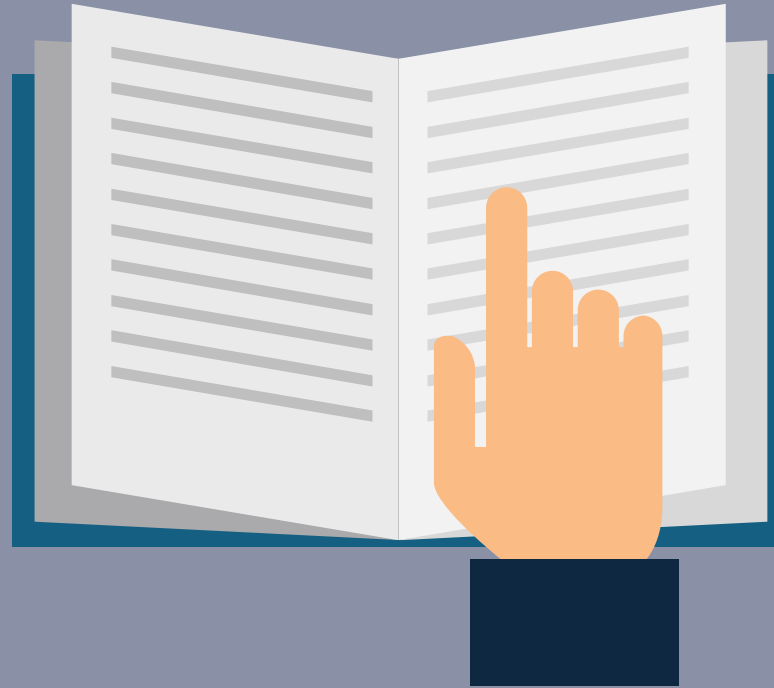

The legal profession is rapidly transforming, driven by **technological advancements**, regulatory reforms, and emerging socio-economic challenges.

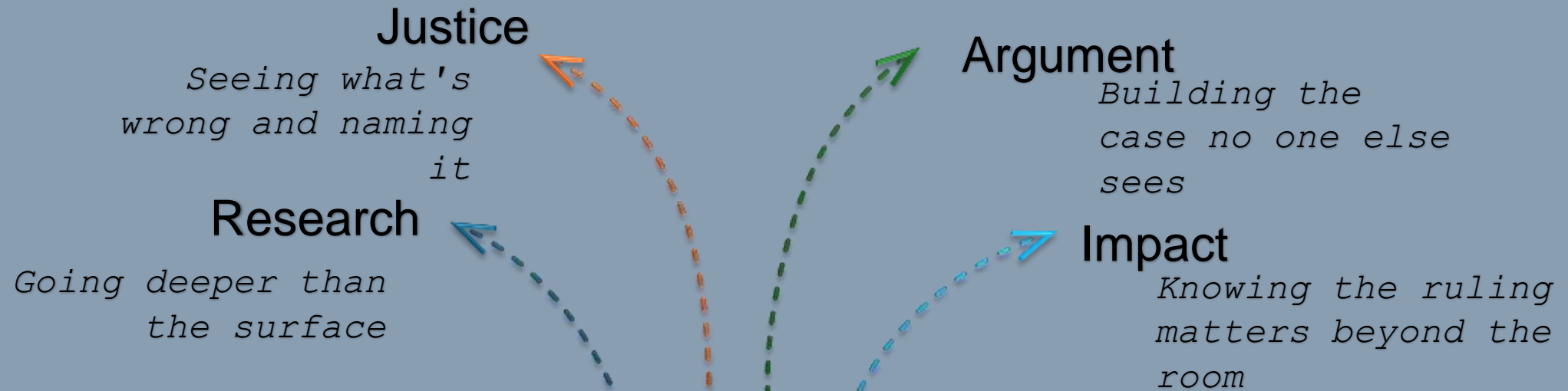

1

Proposal Submission

Submit your proposition outlining the constitutional gap and proposed legal approach.

2

Shortlisting

Entries judged on originality, clarity, and depth – top participants are shortlisted.

3

Writ Submission

Shortlisted participants draft and submit a full Writ Petition.

4

Final Adjudication

Petitions are assessed on legal reasoning, research, and persuasiveness.

Select petitions will be taken beyond the competition and presented before the actual court of law by the participants

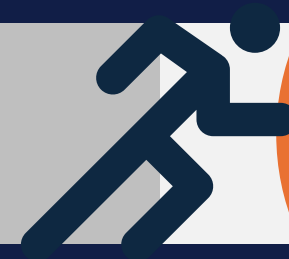

- Maximum 3 pages for representation; 16 pages for writ petition English language only
- Format: Times New Roman, 14 pt, 1.5 line spacing
- Handwritten submissions will not be accepted
- Zero Plagiarism: Original work only, strictly no overlapping content for representation.
- For drafting Writ Petition, Lejit AI application to be used only
- Must be free of grammatical errors; Ensure structural coherence and evidence-based argumentation
- Submission: Participants must sign all pages, scan, and email to the designated ID
